DRAMA & DYNASTIES: NEW ADDITIONS TO 2018 TRIBECA TV® FESTIVAL LINEUP

Added Programming Includes a Special Conversation with Bravo's The Real Housewives of New York City with Andy Cohen and the Season 5 Premiere of FOX's Empire

New Participants Include: Laverne Cox; Tim Daly, Erich Bergen, and Zeljko Ivanek for CBS'
Madam Secretary; Mira Sorvino for Sony Crackle's StartUp

NEW YORK, NY – September 5, 2018 – The Tribeca TV Festival is bringing fans even more special moments with new additions to its 2018 line-up. The Festival will celebrate 10 years of Bravo's *The Real Housewives of New York City* with a one-time-only conversation for fans between Executive Producers **Andy Cohen** and **Lisa Shannon** along with cast members **Sonja Morgan, Dorinda Medley**, and **Tinsley Mortimer**. The program will also expand with the 5th season premiere of FOX's *Empire*, followed by a conversation with star **Jussie Smollett**. The Tribeca TV Festival will take place September 20-23 at Spring Studios in New York City.

Laverne Cox will host a conversation with Rosario Dawson for the latest event in the Tribeca Talks: The Journey, Inspired by TUMI, series. **Mira Sorvino** will join castmates Ron Perlman, Adam Brody, Edi Gathegi, and Otmara Marrero for the premiere of *StartUp*'s 3rd season. **Tim Daly**, **Erich Bergen**, and **Zeljko Ivanek** will join Téa Leoni for *Madam Secretary*'s 5th season premiere.

Over four days, the Tribeca TV Festival will bring the small screen to the big screen, giving attendees the first chance to see season premieres of returning shows and to discover new series. Each screening will be followed by talks with the creative minds from both behind and in front of the camera. In addition, the Festival will host standalone Tribeca Talks conversations with some of the biggest names in episodic storytelling.

"A decade ago Bravo and the producers of *The Real Housewives* turned the lens on New York City and have turned this franchise into an empire that fans dare not miss," said Paula Weinstein, EVP of Tribeca Enterprises. "Both *The Real Housewives* and *Empire* are true appointment TV shows and will be fun events for audiences to experience together at the Tribeca TV Festival."

"For ten years, New York City has been the backdrop for some of the most explosively real drama on television," said **Andy Cohen**, executive producer of *The Real Housewives* franchise. "I'm excited to dig into the behind the scenes stories of making the show."

Tribeca TV Festival brings people together to discover and celebrate episodic storytelling on any screen from TV to online, mobile to VR. Created by Tribeca Enterprises in 2017, parent company of the Tribeca Film Festival, the Tribeca TV Festival is an extension of Tribeca's April TV program and the first dedicated TV festival created by a film festival. In its inaugural year, the TV Festival hosted the surprise world premiere screening of Will & Grace's (NBC) reboot, new series At Home With Amy Sedaris (truTV), Liar (SundanceTV), sneaks of Better Things (FX), Red Oaks (Amazon), Gotham (FOX), conversations with Trevor Noah and writers of The Daily Show, Released (OWN) with Oprah Winfrey, and more.

Tribeca has a tradition of introducing audiences to critically acclaimed and commercially successful episodic shows, which included *Bobby Kennedy for President* (Netflix), *Cobra Kai* (YouTube Red), *Rest in Power: The Trayvon Martin Story* (Paramount Network), *Sweet Bitter* (STARZ), *The Handmaid's Tale* (Hulu), *The Night Of* (HBO), *The Night Manager* (AMC), *Genius* (National Geographic); in addition to debuting new seasons and sneak peek special screenings of returning fan favorites like *Westworld* (HBO), *Unbreakable Kimmy Schmidt* (Netflix), *Broad City* (Comedy Central), *Grace and Frankie* (Netflix); hosting special event screenings for programs like *O.J.: Made in America* (ESPN Films); and bringing cast and filmmakers together for one-night-only conversations celebrating TV milestones such as the finale of *The Good Wife* (CBS) and the 15th anniversary of *Six Feet Under* (HBO)'s final episode.
