MOLLY QUINN

Molly recently wrapped production on the Newline Cinema film WE'RE THE MILLERS, directed by Ross Thurber where she stars opposite Jennifer Aniston, Jason Sudeikas, and Emma Roberts. Past credits include working alongside Rene Zellweger and Logan Lerman in MY ONE AND ONLY, and showcasing her comedic skills alongside John C. Reilly in WALK HARD: THE DEWEY COX STORY. She has additionally worked for acclaimed director Robert Zemeckis in the motion-capture version of the Charles Dickens classic, A CHRISTMAS CAROL, alongside Gary Oldman.

When Molly's not in front of the camera, she works on numerous projects as a voice over artist. Most recently cast to voice the role of Super Girl for Warner Bros. Animation & DC Comics, she has also voiced roles for Cartoon Network's hit series, "Ben 10: Ultimate Alien", and is currently the voice of Bloom in Nickelodeon's hit series, "The Winx Club".

MICHAEL WELCH

Michael Welch is best known for his role as the popular Mike Newton in THE TWILIGHT SAGA FILM SERIES (2008-2011).

Welch has demonstrated his intense depth and commitment to his craft by assuming challenging roles as the leading man. Independent films such as BORN BAD, UNREQUITED and LOST DREAM are just some examples. In 2011 Welch filmed the much anticipated movie, THE BOYS OF ABU GHRAIB.

Welch can be seen in award-winning festival favorites such as ARCHIE'S FINAL PROJECT, AN AMERICAN CRIME, UNITED STATES OF LELAND, AMERICAN SON, ALL THE BOYS LOVE MANDY LANE, and THE COVER-UP.

Welch is familiar to television audiences for his many starring roles on Emmy Award- winning shows, most recently "Criminal Minds" and "Bones". During the past few years he has appeared on "CSI," "The Riches," "CSI: Miami," "Numb3rs," "Law & Order: SVU," "Crossing Jordan," "NCIS," "Cold Case," and "Without a Trace." His earlier years included performances on "Stargate SG-1," "Judging Amy," "The District," "Touched by an Angel," "Malcolm in the Middle," "The X-Files," "The Pretender," "7th Heaven," "Chicago Hope," and "Frasier."

Michael is the recipient of two Young Artist Awards. First for his performance in STAR TREK INSURRECTION at the age of 10, and the second for his work as Luke Girardi on the hit television series "Joan of Arcadia," which ran for two seasons on CBS. Welch won best actor at the 2011 First Glance Film Festival in Hollywood for his portrayal of a troubled young man in UNREQUITED. In spite of his busy schedule, it is essential to Michael to give back. He received the 2005 Star Innovative Award for environmental causes and has been active with the charity Kids With a Cause since 1999. During 2010, Welch was invited to Germany by the USO, working with both wounded soldiers and over 600 military youth. Welch was Co-Chair for 4th annual Walk on The Horizon, an event to raise awareness and resources for adults with disabilities. Welch received the Pioneering Spirit Award from The Thirst Project for his outstanding efforts. Michael's \$5 Buck Club raised \$20,000 to help drill wells for clean drinking water in Swaziland. Welch supported Twilight Mothers of Georgia, for the Ronald McDonald Charity Gala.

CARY ELWES

Cary Elwes made his cinematic debut in 1984 in Marek Kanievska's film ANOTHER COUNTRY based on the award winning play. He then starred in the highly acclaimed historical drama, LADY JANE. That same year Elwes starred in the classic fairy-tale THE PRINCESS BRIDE. The following year, he joined Morgan Freeman and Denzel Washington in the Academy Award winning civil war epic GLORY. Elwes then joined Tom Cruise and Nicole Kidman to work on the high-speed action movie, DAYS OF THUNDER. Elwes' body of work includes HOT SHOTS, BRAM STOKER'S DRACULA, ROBIN HOOD: MEN IN TIGHTS, RUDYARD KIPLING'S THE JUNGLE BOOK, TWISTER, LIAR, LIAR, KISS THE GIRLS: FROM THE EARTH TO THE MOOM, CRADLE WILL ROCK, SHADOW OF THE VAMPIRE, and THE CAT'S MEOW. Elwes also starred in the smash hit psychological thriller, SAW. He was also in Garry Marshall's GEORGIA RULE alongside Jane Fonda, Felicity Huffman and Lindsay Lohan. He recently worked with Gary Marshall again in NEW YEAR'S EVE for New Line. Other credits include A CHRISTMAS CAROL for Robert Zemeckis and THE ADVENTURES OF TINTIN for Steven Speilberg. He just wrapped BEHAVING BADLY opposite Selena Gomez, Nat Wolff and Mary Louise Parker.

LARA FLYNN BOYLE

Lara Flynn Boyle first rose to fame in the television movie of the week THE PREPPIE MURDER, opposite Billy Baldwin. This led to a starring role in the groundbreaking cult classic series "Twin Peaks" for ABC.

Boyle went on to star in a string of critically acclaimed features including Alan Rudolph's EQUINOX and AFTERGLOW, John Dahl's RED ROCK WEST, Alan Parker's THE ROAD TO WELLVILLE, Clint Eastwood's THE ROOKIE, Todd Solondz's HAPPINESS and Andrew Fleming's THREESOME.

Other films include DEAD POET'S SOCIETY, WHERE THE DAY TAKES YOU, the comedy hit

WAYNE'S WORLD and a starring role in the blockbuster feature MEN IN BLACK II along with Will Smith and Tommy Lee Jones. Boyle starred and co-produced the feature WEST TEXAS CHILDREN'S STORY.

Boyle is perhaps best associated with her Emmy nominated role as Helen Gamble in David E. Kelley's Award winning drama series "The Practice." She also received notable recognition for her recurring roles in the NBC hit series "Las Vegas" and the Showtime series "Huff."

A native of Chicago, Boyle began her career upon graduation from The Chicago Academy for the Arts. Boyle has been outspoken about being dyslexic and has supported many causes associated to this issue.

ABOUT THE FILMMAKERS

DUANE JOURNEY (DIRECTOR)

Duane Journey is celebrating his 30th year in the film and television industry by making his feature film directorial debut, with HANSEL AND GRETEL GET BAKED. He recently produced the 3D thriller, JULIA X starring Kevin Sorbo and Ving Rhames, while simultaneously overseeing post production on his previous film, NO GOD, NO MASTER starring Academy Award Nominee, David Strathairn, Ray Wise and Sam Whitmire.

He began the directing phase of his career doing commercials for Aeria Games, Clikthrough Entertainment, Stacker Energy Drinks and Honda. He directed the self-help DVD for internationally known Soul Intuitive and Motivational Speaker, Eddie Conner. He developed and directed the pilot, "Home for the Holidays" for Velvet Steamroller. He produced and codirected the pilot for "The Screaming Cocktail Hour" with Jerry O'Connell, Krista Allen and Peter Stomare, for Spike-TV.

Journey was the Vice-President of production and Chief Operations Officer for Velvet Steamroller, an equity-based production company. While with Velvet Steamroller, he acted as Supervising Producer on 2001 MANIACS starring Robert Englund and Lin Shaye, which was released by Lions Gate; THE THIRD NAIL starring Charles S. Dutton and Krista Allen; WALKING BACK THE CAT and VAMPIRE JUSTICE. He also oversaw production on the Hip Hop documentary, THERE'S A GOD ON A MIC with interviews by Will Smith, Jay-Z and Lil' Kim.

As Head of Production for Sierra Pictures, a company specializing in documentaries, Journey organized shooting throughout the Middle East for the ten-part series HAL LINDSEY'S TOUR OF THE HOLY LANDS, and HAL LINDSEY'S RETURN TO THE HOLY LANDS. Mr. Journey also spent several years working for a television commercial production house, United Odyssey, Inc., as their Head of Production, overseeing the production of 40-plus commercials.

Prior to becoming a producer, Journey worked on the production side of the entertainment industry, coming up through the ranks as a Grip, Dolly Grip, Key Grip, Electrician, and Gaffer. Having a vast knowledge of the physical workings of production has given him definite advantage as a producer. Journey has also worked in television on the shows "Sliders" starring

Jerry O'Connell, "Alias" starring Jennifer Garner, "Felicity" starring Keri Russell, and "thirtysomething" starring Ken Olin and Timothy Bottoms.

He is currently in pre-production on the upcoming feature GHOST LIGHT, which will start production in April 2013.

DAVID TILLMAN (WRITER)

David Tillman is an actor, director and screenwriter residing in Los Angeles. Acting had always been his first love, having performed in such classics as *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest, Mame,* and *A Chorus Line.* He toured for a year in the internationally known *Up With People Show.* David went on to direct such plays as *Little Shop of Horrors, Frankie and Johnnie and the Clair De Lune,* and *Burn This!*

On television, David has been in "Beyond" with James Van Praagh, "The Power Rangers Turbo" and numerous commercials. The writing bug hit and David has been creating stories ever since. He started writing and directing "Vampire Survivor" a spoof of "Survivor." The feature version of his award winning short film, LOVE IS ALL YOU NEED is in pre-production with Camilla Belle and Kellan Lutz attached to star. He is also in development with Joel Silver's Silver Pictures on a paranormal procedural TV series.

JAMES COTTON (PRODUCER)

James' formal education began at The London International Film School and continued at The Los Angeles Film School. Roger Corman contacted the latter, looking to use alumni in a joint-production. James was selected to direct. The completed project, DEMON SLAYER, was made for \$80,000 played on SyFy, and has grossed over \$3M in worldwide distribution since 2002.

James formed Dark Highway Films in 2005 to produce his second feature, SUGAR CREEK which has been in distribution since July of 2006. James and Dark Highway next produced RESURRECTION COUNTY, which he also wrote, and was distributed in 2012 to rave horror reviews.

In 2009, James directed Maya Entertainment's highest grossing film, THE LINE, starring Andy Garcia, Ray Liotta, Esai Morales and Danny Trejo. It closed the New York Latino Film Festival and had a limited theatrical run. It was also a Blockbuster 'exclusive,' where it ranked among the Top 10 Video Rentals in America for three straight weeks. Since that time, James has produced a number of films, including Darren Lynn Bousman's DEVIL'S CARNIVAL, and MADISON COUNTY.

James is also an owner of the Santa Monica based, state of the art post facility, Local Hero Post, which has completed Universal's PITCH PERFECT, Lionsgate's HAUNTING IN CONNECTICUT 2, and Tribeca Film Festival Audience Award Winner, ANY DAY NOW.

E. THOMPSON (PRODUCER)

E. Thompson started his producing career as a development executive at Maverick Films. Thompson went on to become President of the genre label Maverick Red, a subdivision of

Maverick Films, and has had multiple first look overall deals with companies including Gold Circle Films, Maverick Films, and Paramount Pictures.

During his tenure at Maverick, Thompson was involved as an executive on the films AGENT CODY BANKS, the sequel AGENT CODY BANKS II: DESTINATION LONDON for MGM, "30 Days Until I'm Famous" with VH-1, THE GRAVEDANCERS, CRUEL WORLD, MATERIAL GIRLS, and FX's "The Riches," starring Eddie Izzard and Minnie Driver. While at Maverick, he oversaw development and production on films including MY SASSY GIRL, TWILIGHT, and PERCY JACKSON & THE OLYMPIANS: THE LIGHTNING THIEF. He also produced the independent feature SAM'S LAKE for Lionsgate.

Thompson recently completed the horror/thriller feature RITES OF SPRING under his independent label Vigilante Entertainment, with IFC Films distributing.

MICHAEL POLLACK (PRODUCER)

Michael Pollack has held leadership positions for more than 25 years in the legal, financial and entertainment industries. Michael is the founder and former President of a litigation support firm (Asset Source International) that is today part of an international group of companies called STA International. He has held directorship positions for more than a dozen financial institutions that are both private and publicly held.

Michael is the Managing Partner of KK&P, a motion picture and stage production company. He has been involved in the production of theatre and screen features for more than 20 years. Michael has recently produced, A STAR FOR ROSE. His current projects include a TV miniseries titled "Quattrocento," a Broadway play titled *Revolutions*, and upcoming film features THE CROP DUSTER'S DIARY, MAJOR, and FREEDOM FOR JOE.

BRETT HUDSON (PRODUCER)

MARK MORGAN (EXECUTIVE PRODUCER)

Mark Morgan worked at New Regency and Warner Bros. as a story editor working on various films including A TIME TO KILL, MURDER AT 1600, L.A. CONFIDENTIAL and HEAT. Morgan moved on to be a Director of Development and later a Vice President of Production at Orion/MPCA, where he was involved in the development and production of film projects such as BEVERLY HILLS NINJA, KINGPIN, and RINGMASTER. When Orion/MPCA split off to form Destination Films, he served as Executive Vice President of the company and produced the films BEAUTIFUL, SLACKERS, and THE WEDDING PLANNER.

Morgan moved on to become partner and CEO at Maverick Films, founded by Guy Oseary and Madonna. At Maverick, Morgan produced projects including AGENT CODY BANKS, AGENT CODY BANKS 2: DESTINATION LONDON, SAM'S LAKE, MY SASSY GIRL, and MATERIAL GIRLS. He also executive produced the critically acclaimed FX series "The Riches" starring Eddie Izzard and Minnie Driver.

In 2008, Morgan formed Imprint Entertainment and produced TWILIGHT, which he had originally optioned in 2002 as a yet-unpublished manuscript by Stephanie Meyer. Morgan went on to produce The Twilight Saga sequels NEW MOON, ECLIPSE, BREAKING DAWN PART 1,

and BREAKING DAWN PART 2 for Summit Entertainment. Under his Imprint banner, Morgan also produced THE STEPFATHER for Screen Gems and PERCY JACKSON & THE OLYMPIANS: THE LIGHTNING THIEF for Sony Pictures.

In 2009, Morgan won the Vision Award "Producer of Vision," and the 2009 MTV Movie Award for Best Movie of the Year for TWILIGHT. He won the award again in 2010 for NEW MOON.
